ID Cards

School students, teachers, administration, support staff, volunteers, and visitors will be required to wear identification (ID) cards at all times on school grounds. ID cards will be necessary for library book checkouts, cafeteria purchases, and other school functions deemed necessary by the administration. Student ID cards should be worn around the neck or with a clip outside of clothing above the waist and be clearly visible. They should not be altered in any way, shape, or form. Any student who alters an ID from its original form will be required to purchase another ID at a cost of \$5.00. If a student does not have their ID, they can (1) purchase a temporary ID for \$1.00 or (2) purchase a new ID card and lanyard for \$5 or an ID card for \$3 or a lanyard for \$3. ***Students may purchase a maximum of three (3) temporary ID cards during an academic school year.*** A student not having money may charge the cost but must reimburse the school by the end of the academic school year.

To obtain a temporary ID, students must sign-in in the main office prior to the following times:

BLHS: 8:10 A.M.
BLMS: 7: 51 AM
LLC: 7:30 AM
BLES: 8:00 AM
BLPS: 7:45 AM

Note: *If a student signs in after the approved time, they will still be allowed to obtain a temporary ID but they will be considered tardy to class, unless they have an approved written excuse. The student will receive appropriate disciplinary action as required by the student handbook.*

BLPS, BLES, BLMS, LLC, and BLHS students are required to wear ID cards only during school hours. BLPS and BLES students will leave their ID cards in their classroom with their teacher at the end of the day. BLMS, LLC, and BLHS students are responsible for keeping up with their ID cards during and after-school hours.

Any student at BLMS, LLC, or BLHS using or displaying another student's i.d card will automatically receive 5 demerits for dishonesty.

After the 4th offense for failure to wear an i.d card at BLMS, LLC, and BLHS, it will be considered a Level I offense for students.

The following disciplinary actions will be taken at BLMS, LLC, and BLHS:

Note: Demerits will be applied to the student's running total of all disciplinary offenses. The appropriate disciplinary action will be determined according to the student handbook based upon the total number of demerits the student has accumulated to date.

(BLHS)

1st -3rd offenses, Warning & Temporary ID, \$1.00 charge.
4th and all other offenses, 5 demerits & Purchase of new ID, \$5.00 charge

(BLMS & LLC)

1st -3rd offenses, Warning & Temporary ID, \$1.00 charge.
4th and all other offenses, 5 demerits & Purchase of new ID, \$5.00 charge

The following disciplinary actions will be taken at BLPS and BLES. These schools do not use a demerit system.

(BLES)

15 minutes of detention during recess time.

1st- 3rd offenses, Warning, Temporary ID, \$1.00 Charge
4th and all other offenses, 1 Recess Detention & Purchase of a new ID, \$5.00 Charge

(BLPS)

15 minutes of detention during recess time.

1st- 3rd offenses, Warning, Temporary ID, \$1.00 Charge
4th and all other offenses, 1 Recess Detention & Purchase of a new ID, \$5.00 Charge
